

Emergency Showers

As Oil and Gas rigs continue to grow in number in remote and desolate locations, so does the need for rugged, mobile equipment to support the key personnel who work those rigs.

At one time Emergency Showers on site were a luxury, but now are a necessity for the safety conscious site manager. An Emergency Shower is designed to instantly douse either a person's entire body or just their eyes/face with water in the event that they've been exposed to a hazardous substance.

There are many different sizes and configurations for Emergency Showers. Some are designed for single person use, while others are multi. Some are inside a structure while others are outside. No matter the size or variety, the most important thing to consider when purchasing or providing an Emergency Shower is that it has been manufactured by a reputable company and that it meets or exceeds, and is tested for all ANSI standards related to Emergency Showers. Also imperative in the selection of an Emergency Shower is its ability to operate flawlessly in environment that it will be used in.

To avoid potential problems, always be sure to request documentation that the Emergency Shower manufacturer has built the unit to comply with ANSI specs, and that the unit has been tested to meet those specs recently.
